

The purposes of the corporation are to:

1. Provide accessible mental health support through neurofeedback training, meditation, and mindfulness practices, particularly to youth and families in marginalized and underserved communities;
2. Offer free neurofeedback programs to individuals aged 12 to 29 to foster emotional regulation, mental clarity, and overall well-being;
3. Deliver affordable neurofeedback services to nonprofit organizations whose employees seek mental health support as part of self-care and professional wellness initiatives;
4. Promote emotional resilience, trauma recovery, and self-awareness through culturally grounded, science-based, and contemplative approaches to mental wellness;
5. Develop and implement educational and outreach programs that support holistic healing and inner transformation, rooted in both modern neuroscience and contemplative traditions.

Special Provisions

1. The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used solely in promoting its objects.
2. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, and after payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed to one or more organizations in Canada with similar objects, and which are registered charities under the Income Tax Act (Canada), as determined by the directors of the corporation.
3. The corporation shall not issue shares or declare dividends.
4. The corporation shall operate exclusively for charitable or not-for-profit purposes and shall not directly or indirectly carry on a trade or business for profit.

6. The special provisions are:

a. Commercial purposes, if any, included in the articles are intended only to advance or support one or more of the non-profit purposes of the corporation. No part of a corporation's profits or of its property or accretions to the value of the property may be distributed, directly or indirectly, to a member, a director or an officer of the corporation except in furtherance of its activities or as otherwise permitted by this Act.

b. The corporation shall be subject to the Charities Accounting Act.

c. No director shall receive remuneration for services provided in the capacity as a director, although they may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties. Unless otherwise prohibited by the corporation, a director may be compensated for services other than as a director pursuant to the regulation made under the Charities Accounting Act, or with court approval or an order made under section 13 of the Charities Accounting Act.

d. To invest the funds of the corporation pursuant to the Trustee Act.

e. Upon the dissolution of the corporation and after satisfying the interests of its creditors in all its debts, obligations and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed to a Canadian body corporate that is a registered charity under the Income Tax Act (Canada) with similar purposes to its own, the Crown in right of Ontario, the Crown in right of Canada, an agent of either of those Crowns or a municipality in Canada.
